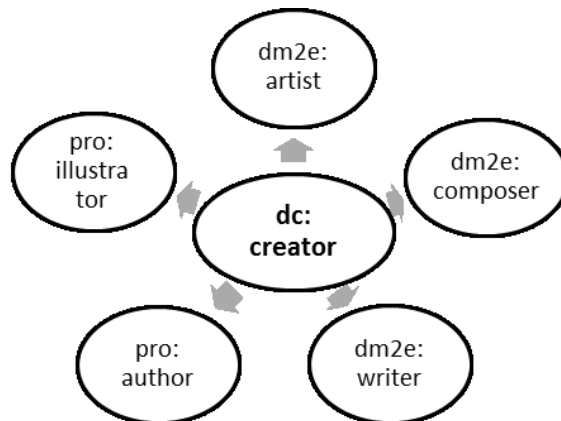


Fig. 1 Example figure (Times New Roman, 9 pts.)
